

### Neighborhood

Located in the dynamic and evolving Omonia district, this area is gaining momentum with significant investments reshaping its urban landscape. Major developments from prominent companies are elevating the neighborhood's profile Adjacent to the vibrant Exarcheia neighborhood, known for its colorful street art, eclectic bars, cafés, and cultural energy, Omonia offers a rich blend of urban renewal and artistic expression. Its proximity to universities and the soon-to-berenovated National Archaeological Museum adds further appeal for students, professionals, and cultural enthusiasts alike.



### The Story of the Building

This distinctive and enchanting building was originally an industrial space that served as the main printing house in Athens. It boasts high ceilings of about 4 meters, timeless columns, original terrazzo flooring, and large windows flooding the space with natural light, showcasing mid-century architectural elements that graced it.

Currently used as a studio by its artistic owners, a mother and son who are both painters, the owners have decided to sell due to the space being too large for their needs. The 5-story property will be transformed into a unique residential building with 29 apartments





Roxani MARAGKOUDAKI








### Floor Plan I Ground Floor








Concept Design / Interior Visuals / Ground Floor Lobby

## Floorplan I First Floor






